**12 Weeks Gestation**

- The neck is present and the face well formed.
- The eyelids close and will reopen at about 24 weeks.
- Tooth buds appear.
- The arms and legs move.
- All the body parts and organs are present.
- The fibers that carry pain to the brain are developed.
- Definitive signs of male and female gender are present.
- A heartbeat can be heard with electronic devices.
- The length is about 2 to 3 inches.

**14 Weeks Gestation**

- The skin is almost transparent.
- The mouth makes sucking motions.
- Amniotic fluid is swallowed.
- Sweat glands develop.
- The liver and pancreas are starting to work.
- The length is about 3 to 4 inches.
